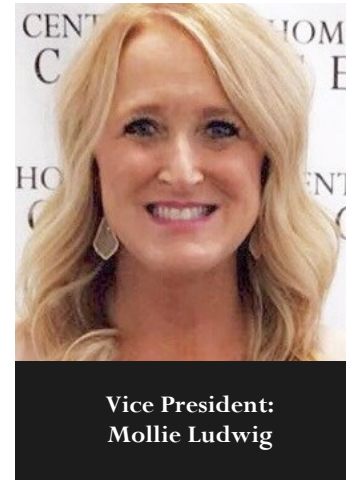
# Congratulation Mollie Ludwig!

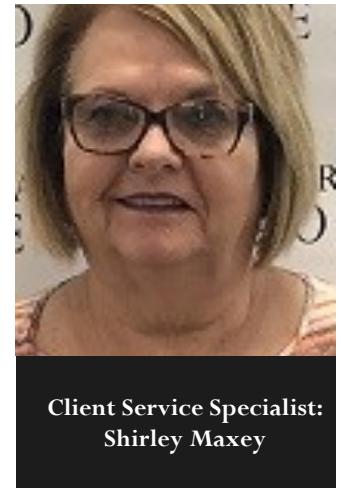
